SEALED BIDS for the furnishing of the necessary materials and construction of

SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION ALONG STATE STREET,
LOWELL STREET AND CONNON ROAD
HILLMAN, MICHIGAN

will be received at the Village of Hillman office located at 24220 Veteran's Memorial Highway, Hillman, Michigan 48746 until:

3:00 P.M., LOCAL TIME

and at that time and place will be publicly opened and read aloud.

2. The proposed work consists of approximately 2160 linear feet of 8 inch diameter sanitary sewer (some sewers to be installed by directional drilling) together with eight manholes and appurtenances.

3. The Bidding Documents, including Drawings and Project Manual with Specifications, are on file at the Village office and at the office of May & Associates, Inc., 3197 W. M-76, Suite B, West Branch, MI 48661. A set may be obtained by depositing \$15.00 (plus \$10.00 if documents are to be mailed), check only, with said Village Office. **Checks shall be made payable to Village of Hillman.** Deposits are non-refundable.

Additional copies (in excess of one) of the Drawings and Project Manual may be purchased at a cost of \$15.00 (plus \$10.00 if documents are to be mailed). No refund will be allowed for the return of any additional copies.

5. **Each recipient of bid documents may be listed as a plan holder.**

The Village of Hillman reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Bids, to reject the bid of a Bidder who is not, in the opinion of the Village, qualified to perform the Contract, to waive informalities, and to reject non-conforming, non-responsive or conditional Bids. The Village of Hillman also reserves the right to award the Contract in the Village's best interest, and therefore, may also reject the Bid of any Bidder if the Village of Hillman believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Village to make an award to that Bidder. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance, labor and material bonds, and insurance policies as detailed in the Contract Documents.

7. Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, or bid bond, in the amount of at least 5 percent of the amount bid, drawn payable to Village of Hillman, as security for the proper execution of the Contract.
